Title:	How similar can non-isomorphic algebraic structures be? A gentle introduction to Model Theory with group- theoretic examples.

Abstract:

I will discuss one of the main notions of Model Theory - elementary equivalence, a certain similarity relation between algebraic structures which is coarser than the isomorphism relation.

As an illustration I will describe this relation in some classes of groups where the problem leads to interesting and non-trivial algebraic questions.
