

### Location of the Campus:

Koç University Campus is located north of the European side of Istanbul. It is beyond the city limits and built inside a forest with a wide view of Black Sea. The architecture is reminiscent of old Istanbul Palaces. The University moved to its new campus in 2000.

### Reaching the Campus:

We arranged for a midi-bus to meet you at the International Atatürk Airport on Sunday afternoon, 8 July 2007 at 16:30 in front of the International Arrivals. If you cannot make it the easiest way to reach the Campus is to take a taxi from the Airport. Make sure that the driver opens the taximeter. Trip takes 45 kilometers and costs about 35 dollars during daytime. (Taxi rates increase by 50% after midnight) There are Security Personnel 24 hours a day at the University Gate. They will guide you to your rooms at the Henry Ford Guest House that will be reserved to your names or they can give a call to the organisers if help is needed.

### Going to Istanbul:

The nearest town center is at Sariyer that is along the coast 4 kilometers from the Campus. There is University Shuttle Service to Sariyer but it is not very frequent. Dolmus minibuses on the other hand are running at all times to and from Sariyer. (They are privately operated with no timetables. "Dolmus" in Turkish means "full and ready to go".) Dolmus trip takes about 15 minutes one way and costs less than a dollar. It is not much more expensive to use a taxi to go to Sariyer. Secretaries and/or Security Personnel can help you call a taxi. Once in Sariyer, you can either get on a city bus (25A to Levent where several rich Shopping Centers are located or 40B to Taksim that is the Bohemian center of Istanbul) or take another dolmus to Besiktas (where traditional shops and food can be found). You can come back the same way.
